July 17-22, 2011 Cost: \$200

July 10-15, 2011 Cost: \$150 + \$25 Kayak Fee for Youth 12 and up

Campers will enjoy sports, games, archery, arts and crafts, nature experiences, music and drama, making new friends, experiencing evening campfires, outdoor cooking, and many other exciting activities.

Counselor-In-Training (CIT) Program For teens entering 10th grade-completion of 12th grade (under 18 years)
Mandatory training will be July 8-10, 2011. Camp will be July 10-15, 2011

Cost: CIT at Discovery Camp only \$150; Attending as both a Discovery Camp CIT & Action Camper \$275 (Total).

This is an exciting program available for young adults in which they have a chance to develop leadership skills that will serve them throughout their lives. CITs work directly with counselors & campers alike and participate in all aspects of Discovery Camp. Youth wishing to be a CIT must fill out the CIT application.

Fee Structure

There will be a \$25 non-refundable application fee/deposit for all campers. Registration deadline is June 1, 2011. Applications postmarked or hand delivered after June 1 will be assessed an additional \$25 non-refundable fee per camper and no applications will be accepted after June 15th, 2011. There will be a 25% discount for a second or any subsequent campers from the same household attending one or both camps. The discount is calculated on the \$150 base rate and does not apply towards the kayak fees or fees assessed on applications postmarked after June 1st.

Scholarships may be available and will be awarded at the discretion of the camp deans based on financial need and considered on a first come, first served basis. Scholarship applicants are encouraged to apply early! Scholarships can be requested by filling out the scholarship application.
